

Arthur M. & Berdena King Eagle Scout Scholarship

Sons of the American Revolution (SAR) Empire State Society (ESS) Long Island Chapter (LIC)



Open to all Eagle Scouts who are currently registered in an active unit and have not reached their 19th birthday during the year of application. (The application year is the calendar year, 01 Jan. to 31 Dec.) The year that Eagle was awarded is not restricted. College plans do not need to be completed in order to receive the cash scholarship. Three cash scholarship awards are given: As the National First Place winner - \$8,000.00; Runner-up - \$4,000.00; 2nd runner-up - \$2,000.00. You may apply more than one year if you meet the age requirements but no more than \$8,000.00 total may be granted to any one Eagle Scout.



Entrants need to complete only one application per year -- the one for the chapter competition. Regardless of it being a winner or not, it is then used for the state competition. The top state winners are then forwarded to be used for the national competition.

The application consists of:

1. The two page application form
2. The Four Generation ancestor chart
3. The 500 word essay

Prizes and recognition's are also be awarded at the SAR Chapter and State levels.

Note: Applications are accepted during a calendar year for Scholarships to be awarded in the Spring of the following year. It is best to submit the applications as close to the end of the year as possible in order to increase the chances of winning. However, do not send in the application on or after January 1st for the previous year.

The competition is conducted in three phases, local (Chapter), State (Society), and National. The competition is entered through the Chapter level. You may enter at the state level and forgo the Chapter level, but no Chapter Awards will be given. You may not enter at the National level.
