ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for financial assistance a Youth must be 1) registered and in good standing with the Scout's unit.; 2) in need of financial help in order to attend Summer Camp ; 3) recommended for aid by the unit leader and 4) a completed campership application is submitted.

AWARDING CAMPERSHIP

There must be no promise made to applicants that they will receive campership support.

We desire that all camperships be awarded with a minimum of publicity in order to avoid any embarrassment for recipients. We desire the minimum of disappointment if funds are insufficient to help all applicants.

Award of a campership will be dependent on need and the availability of funds. Awards are made as follows:

- FULL SHARE: An amount not to exceed half the camp fee.
- PARTIAL SHARE 1 An amount not to exceed one-third of the camp fee.
- PARTIAL SHARE 2 An amount not to exceed one-quarter of the camp fee.

The pro-rated amount of each share will be set based on available funds, so each share level may be awarded at less than the maximum amount stipulated.

The amount of the campership will be credited to the unit's camp account, or in the case of provisional Scout camping and Cub Scouts camping to the individual Scout's account. It is important to know that camperships are awarded to individual Scouts and may not be transferred to another boy. The balance of camp fees over and above the campership awarded must be paid according to the schedule on the camp application.
