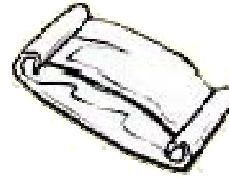

**Directions for Foil Packet:**

Fold long edges of **heavy duty** foil toward center to meet. Fold down in a series of locked folds, allowing room for heat expansion.



Fold in outside edges, crimping to seal.
