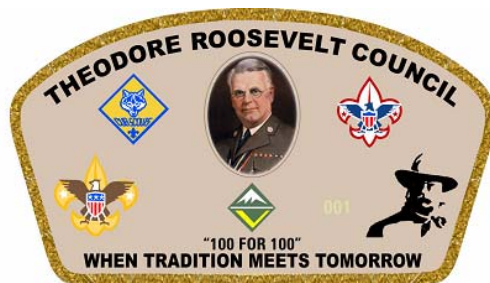




“100 for 100” Preserving Scouting for Another 100 Years

Gifts may also be made in honor of a special accomplishment such as attaining Eagle Scout, Silver Beaver, retirement, or in memory of a special individual. Only 100 of these patches will be produced. Each of the patches will be numbered and only given when the James E. Fellowship gift is paid in full. There will be no reserving a certain numbered patch for future recognition or contribution. The “100 for 100” patch will only be used to recognize **New** James E. West Fellowships contributions received after **December 1st, 2007**. All new members of this “100 for 100” society will be invited to participate in our endowment reception held each year in February
