



## What do I need to bring to camp?

The Official uniform for Bear Claw NYLT is the current Boy Scout Summer Uniform. Wear your uniform to camp. The course program starts immediately after arrival. The participant will carry all gear.

### REQUIRED ITEMS:

- Scout Shorts/Pants  
(at least 2 pair)
- Scout Shirt (short sleeve - 2 )
- Scout Socks  
(at least three pair)
- Scout web belt and buckle
- Raincoat or Poncho
- Wet weather headgear &  
footgear
- Light Jacket or Sweatshirt
- Underclothing - 6 days
- Sleeping bag or blankets
- Flashlight with extra  
batteries
- Camp Medical Form  
signed by parents &  
physician
- Towels & Washcloths
- Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- Hand soap & container
- Mirror
- Brush and/or comb
- Knapsack or pack adequate  
for carrying gear on an  
overnight hike
- Mess kit: plate, bowl cup
- Knife, fork, spoon

- Canteen/Water bottle
- Ground Cloth (Waterproof)
- Two Pens
- Scout pocket knife
- Boy Scout Handbook  
(current edition)
- Two plastic yard trash bags
- Laundry or stuff bag
- Two each 7" x 10" ziplock  
bags
- Hiking shoes/boots (athletic  
shoes not recommended )

### OPTIONAL ITEMS

- Pillow, if desired
- Air Mattress
- Sewing Kit
- Personal First Aid Kit
- Scout Field Book
- Wet stone
- Compass
- Non- aerosol (only) insect  
repellent
- Bugle
- Work gloves
- Long sleeve shirt
- Moccasins or slippers
- Sandals for showering

Do not bring items inconsistent with the Scout Oath and Law.

## How Should I Pack?

- Pack your gear so that it can be hiked in by you from the parking lot to your campsite.
- You will be again carrying a subset of your gear on an overnight hike, perhaps up to 3 miles.

## CONTRABAND (what to leave home):

- Various items of contraband have been established. These include the obvious (tobacco, alcohol and drugs) as well as petroleum based flammables (lighter fluid, WD-40, most aerosol sprays), laser pointers, and electronic games/recording or playback devices, etc.
- Any youth or adult staff member will confiscate contraband on sight, without warning and without providing an opportunity to "keep it packed away." Confiscated items will be held by the Scoutmaster and returned only to the scout's parents at course completion. Any drug violations will be reported to appropriate legal authorities.
- Additionally, any use of tools, supplies, personal or other items, whether contraband or not, that places anyone's health and/or safety at risk or which represents a disregard for the principles of Scouting will be dealt with as a behavior issue.
