

CANOE RENTAL APPLICATION

Canoeing Policies

1. Canoes are available for use by registered units of the Boy Scouts of America. All trips must be made under the leadership of two (2) or more qualified in Safety Afloat, BSA training and are registered adult Scouters (21 years of age or older). Canoes use is limited to Long Island rivers, Long Island Sound, and South Shore sheltered waters.
2. Units using canoes and trailers are responsible for canoe pickup, hauling, and return to camp.
3. Canoes are available to units at \$15.00 per canoe per day, including the use of two personal flotation devices and two paddles per canoe. A "damage" deposit of \$50.00 must be made at the time of application (separate check). Rental fees will be payable at the council service center. CANOE TRAILERS ARE AVAILABLE AT SCHIFF SCOUT RESERVATION at (\$25.00 per day). The full rental fee (less deposit) must be paid PRIOR to canoe and/or trailer pickup. NOTE: Unit will be responsible for all damages and this liability is not limited to the amount of the "damage" deposit.
4. Indicate approximate times of pickup and return. If the ranger is not present, leave equipment where you found it upon pickup. The unit renting a trailer is responsible for providing a trailer hitch and hooking the trailer lights.

Canoeing Availability

5. Canoes are available at SCHIFF SCOUT RESERVATION for Boy Scout, Varsity Scout, and Explorer groups.
6. All adults on canoe trips (two minimum required) must:
 - A. Have completed Safety Afloat & Safe Swim Defence training (at least one adult per 10 Scouts must be certified).
 - B. At least one adult MUST be certified in CPR.
 - C. Be in good health. At least one of these adults must occupy last canoe in down stream canoe trips.
7. All Scouts and Explorers must be registered members, be in good health (physical exam with the past year), be able to swim 50 yards well (blue tag, equivalent), and bring a valid permission slip with them.
8. Canoeing is not permitted in Deep Pond (Schiff Scout Reservation) unless prior approval is secured from the camping department of the Theodore Roosevelt Council.

ALL PERSONS MUST WEAR PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICES AT ALL TIMES STAY WITH YOUR CANOE IF OVERTURNED
